- **Students under 18 are required to attend breakfast Monday through Saturday.**  
Please consult the bulletin boards next to the dining room for lesson times, chamber music assignments, master classes, trip sign-up, etc. This is how we alert you to events and changes in scheduling.
- **Practice Hours: Monday-Saturday 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Monday-Friday 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.**  
Practice during the morning is a 50-minute hour. The 5:00 practice time is a full hour. Under 18 year old students may not leave their dorm for lunch until 12:30 or for dinner until 6:00 pm. No chamber music rehearsals for students under 18 during practice hours. Only piano students may use pianos.
- **Meadowmount Office Hrs: 1:45-4:45 pm. Mon-Sat.** Fax, copy service, and other student business.
- **Music Store/Chamber Music Library hrs: 1:45-3:45p.m. Mon-Sat.** Cash, money orders and traveler's checks are accepted. Personal checks & money orders can be cashed in the office. We do not take Credit Cards.
- **Church Transportation:** begins after the first week of school. Vans leave the Main House on Sunday about 9:00 a.m. for Catholic & Protestant services. No service is provided to other locations.

## RULES

To foster a safe and healthy environment for the Meadowmount community, students are required to abide by the following rules governing behavior. A copy of the rules is also posted in student rooms.

### **VIOLATIONS THAT RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL WITH NO REFUND:**

- **USING/POSSESSING ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS OR ENGAGING IN ILLEGAL ACTIVITY**
- **HARMING ONESELF OR OTHERS**
- **STEALING, DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY, BREAKING/RIPPING WINDOW SCREENS, BREAKING WINDOW FRAMES, TAMPERING WITH FIRE SAFETY EQUIPMENT OR SETTING FIRES (ALL SUBJECT TO FINES)**
- **UNDER 18 STUDENT IN DORMS HOUSING STUDENTS OVER 18 OR IN DORMS OF THE OPPOSITE SEX**
- **STUDENT OVER 18 IN DORMS HOUSING STUDENTS UNDER 18.**
- **LEAVING CAMPUS IF UNDER 18 WITHOUT PROPER SUPERVISION (SEE BELOW)**
- **NOT CO-OPERATING WITH SCHOOL AUTHORITIES**
- **STUDENTS UNDER 18 ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE WOODS ADJACENT TO THE CAMP ROAD OR PATH TO OBSCURE THEMSELVES FROM FULL VIEW OF SUPERVISING PERSONNEL.**

### **FOR STUDENTS UNDER 18-VIOLATIONS WHICH RESULT IN A 1-WEEK SUSPENSION:**

- **ARRIVING MORE THAN 30 MINUTES LATE FOR THE EVENING CURFEW**
- **LEAVING THE DORMITORY AFTER BEING CHECKED IN BY THE COUNSELOR IN CHARGE**
- **LEAVING THE DORMITORY BEFORE 7:15 a.m. MONDAY-SATURDAY OR 7:30 a.m. SUNDAY.**

### **All students:**

Families and relatives are asked to visit between the hours of 12:30 pm Saturday and 10 p.m. Sunday only. We regret we cannot provide overnight accommodations or food service for visitors. **Friends may visit during open concerts ONLY and are not allowed in student housing.** Practice cabins must be signed out for use and only used for rehearsing or practicing. Off campus students are not allowed in the dining room during mealtime. Eating utensils, cups or trays may not be taken out of the dining room. No cooking is permitted in dormitories. Food may be kept in the dorm refrigerator. Food kept in rooms must be in metal, thick plastic or glass containers. Conserve water at all times or we will run out. Report plumbing leaks, drips or running toilets to the Office immediately. Showers are limited to 5 minutes once per day. No laundry is to be done in sinks, a weekly laundry service is provided. For safety, **all students must use the school (dirt) road and not the paved road** when walking back and forth on campus. Smoking in designated areas only. No smoking by under 18 year old students. No candles, burning incense, fireworks, campfires, or pets. No hooks or padlocks are permitted on student doors, a key is provided. All students must leave the Main House at 10:00 p.m. (11 p.m. Saturday). **All students are required to attend all concerts.** For concerts: dress or nice pant outfit for girls. Dress shirt and pants for boys. Ties/ jackets optional. **No** shorts, T-shirts, jeans, sloppy clothes, flip-flops, tennis shoes, midriff showing, see through clothing, or inappropriate clothing. Daily attire: **Modest attire is required at all times.** When in the community exemplary behavior is expected as you represent Meadowmount. By signing the pledge you agree to all rules.

### **Students 18 and older:**

No smoking except in designated smoking areas. Driving limit on campus is 10 MPH; do not use the campus road to drive across campus, use County Route 10. Do not enter any dormitories housing students under the age of 18. No minor may go off campus with any one except a relative and signed permission must be on file in the office. Curfews and quiet hours are 10:30 p.m. for students over 18. During quiet hours, no practicing, playing stereos or loud noise is permitted. **Concert attendance is mandatory.**

### **Students under 18:**

Students under 18 are not allowed off campus without a counselor, faculty member, or a parent/legal guardian. **Students may not leave with another student's parent.** A relative over 18 may take a student off campus but a release form signed by a parent/legal guardian must be on file in the office. State law regulates this rule and there are no exceptions. No smoking allowed by anyone under 18. Door schedules must be filled in with student's whereabouts at all times. Bedroom door must be open when having other students in room. Sleepovers are not permitted. Students must be in their dorms by 10:00 p.m. and in their own rooms by 10:30 p.m. (Saturday night one hour later). **Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. to 7:15 a.m.** (one hour later Saturday night). **During quiet hours, no practicing, playing stereos or loud noise is permitted.** No visiting among students during practice hours or curfew hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:15 a.m./ one hour later Saturday night).

## THE MEADOWMOUNT PLEDGE

As a student of the Meadowmount School, I have read and agree to abide by the School rules. I also agree to abide by the laws of New York State, State Health Department regulations and to cooperate with School administrators in furthering the ideals upon which Meadowmount was founded.

I agree not to possess or use alcoholic beverages on campus and/or to possess or engage in the unauthorized use of drugs at any time and to not hold the School liable in case of injury or death when in violation of School rules.

I have given true and accurate information on my application and understand that misrepresenting my age will result in dismissal from School. The administration reserves the right to expel a student immediately without refunding any part of the fees paid if found in violation of School rules, Health Department regulations or the laws of New York State.

I hereby give consent, while a student at the School, to participate in performances, radio, television, and transcribed programs without compensation and for photographs to be taken at the School for use in School approved publications and advertisements including the website.

I understand my acceptance is dependent upon receipt of the \$600 reservation deposit in the admissions office by April 1<sup>st</sup> and that deposits received after the deadline may result in the loss of my place and/or scholarship. *(Full scholarship students are exempt from this deposit).*
